European Universities Championships 2010 commenced

The 2010 season of the European Universities Championships (EUC) has kicked off with the start of the first championships in Handball (Nicosia, Cyprus), Badminton (Nancy, France), Table Tennis (Kazan, Russia) and eight others coming up in the period of two months.

In 2009, fifteen European Universities Championships were organised, with over 3.000 participants taking part in the championships.
