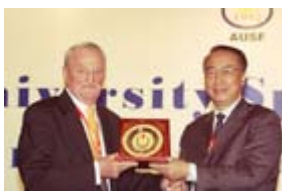
EUSA working meeting in Ljubljana - 7 September 2010
